Tuition

Tuition is due the 1st lesson of each month. Whether you have 3 classes or 5 in a month, tuition will be the same. We do our best to ensure you average 4 lessons a month. PLEASE stay current.

45 minute class - \$30

Mini Prestige - \$75 (for your block of classes)

60 minute class - \$40

Jr. Prestige - \$87.50

75 minute class - \$50

Teen Prestige - \$100

90 minute class - \$60

Sr. Prestige - 117.50

*\$5 discount on your second class. \$7.50 off your third

Costumes

Prestige Teams will have multiple routines so we will go as cheap as possible while still looking professional. The costumes fees are as follows:

Senior Prestige – 3 costumes: \$160 due September 15th

Teen Prestige – 3 costumes: \$140 due September 15th

Junior Prestige - 3 costumes: \$140 due September 15th

Mini Prestige – 3 costumes: \$120 due September 15th

Non-Prestige Classes

\$50 for one child size costume (due September 15th)

\$65 for one adult size costume (due September 15th)

Competitions

Prestige Teams will be competing at 3 competitions:

Utah Dance Championship **tentative** – April 29th & 30th

Open Dance Nationals at Lagoon – May 20th & 21st 2011

Dance Spectacular at Layton, UT – To Be Announced

Non-Prestige teams and all Cheer & Tumbling squads will compete at 1 competition:

Open Dance Nationals at Lagoon – May 20th & 21st 2011

Clogging teams will be competing at 2 competitions:

Thanksgiving Point - March 4-5th, 2011

Clogging Nationals – May 13-14th, 2011

Competition Fees usually run \$12 per routine and are DUE IN JANUARY. Solos or Duets will run substantially more if you choose to go queen. SOLOS ARE BY INVITATION ONLY!

Powerhouse Dress Code

Preferred dance shoes (may vary by team or class) can be ordered through discountdance.com:

Ballet: 1. pink canvas Sansha 3AL
or 2. pink leather Capezio CG2002 (adult) / or CG2002C (child)

Jazz: Depending on your dance you will need one of the following:

1. Gore boots CG05 (adult) / CG05C (child) specify TAN or BLACK (NOT CARMEL or SUNTAN). Practice shoe can be any color. Competition shoe color choice will be determined at a later date.

2. Dance paws DPL - original / or DPP padded

DRESS CODE

Pre-Dance: Footless tight and leotards, pink ballet shoes, and black tap shoes. No street shoes, sweats, T-shirts or baggy clothes. Hair pulled away from face (But ponytails and clips hurt to roll on!)

Pre-Ballet: pink shoes (not the satin slippers). Shoes must fit like sock! Pink tights and pink leotard.

Ballet classes: pink shoes, black leotard, pink tights, short wrap-around skirt (optional), NO BOXERS, SWEATS, OR SHIRTS. Hair must be in a bun or pinned up. PLEASE respect the art of ballet. No jazz/gore boots or dance paws.

Jazz Classes: Boy cut shorts (booty shorts) and a tight fitting top. Dance paws are recommended. No street shoes, bare feet, sweats, T-shirts, or baggy clothes. Hair pulled away from face.

Clogging: Street clothes are allowed and black clogging shoes clogging shoes.

Pre-Dance Combo Tumbling: Any color leotards and footless tights. Form fitting clothes such as tank tops and bikers. Have bare feet. No baggy clothes! Pull hair back, braids preferred. (Ponytails and clips hurt to roll on!)

Hip Hop: Any moveable dance or work out attire, tennis shoes should be worn.

Cheer & Tumbling: Shorts and a tighter fitting Tee Shirt or Tank. Tennis Shoes must be worn! Please do not come in sandals or flip flops.
